INTERPRETATION PACKET – SLIDE #14 (individual sanctions)

Disqualification procedure regarding coaches:

I have received a few questions dealing with the process of disqualified coaches even though I have heard of less than five total disqualifications in all of New York State High School Volleyball last year. Reminder: If a coach is disqualified, that coach can be replaced by a certified volleyball coach from that school district or by a physical education teacher from that school district. (Make sure you have the name of the individual replacing the coach on the scoresheet. We do not ask any individual for proof of certification.) Please check with your section as to how a disqualification should be reported as sectional policies are not always the same throughout the state.
