

The modified-rated referee should be able to demonstrate the basic skills needed to officiate a volleyball match. Minimal expectations for the first referee (R1) include observation of the following:

Pre-match (set) responsibilities

Inspect the playing site note non playable areas Overhead obstructions Replay versus out of play
 Checks the net and official's stand with the second referee (when available)
 Monitors pre-match warm-up and has a pre-match conference with R2
 Discuss ball handling parameters with the R2 during pre-match warm-up (accepted assistance) DO NOT make the R2 a lines judge (when sections have opted for the waiver not to use lines judges)
 Confers with the R2 on communication techniques that will be used during match, requesting sanctions (Quiz)
 Confers with the line judges (when available) and educates them according to level of experience
 Conduct a team representative's meeting and coin toss. Information is delivered in a clear, concise manner and completed in a reasonable amount of time. (About 60 seconds)
 Introductions Ground rules Review of protocols Sportsmanship card
 Safety (Jewelry, headgear, water)
 Introductions to both coaches with the second referee (when available)
 Inform serve or receive Special events Ground rules
 Instruct match personnel as necessary (Announcer, event supervisor)
 Correct uniform. Clean and neat with appearance. Demonstrates poise and proper posture on the stand

Set responsibilities

Signals are clear and sharp with elbows at chin height when appropriate
 Whistle (pause) signal (pause) signal. The signals are held long enough.
 Strong, clear, authoritative whistle. Different whistles for player safety, start and stop play
 Appropriate verbal skills and non-verbal responses: Has an approachable demeanor and positive attitude
 Demonstrates a court scan; right sideline, scan to second referee, left sideline prior to authorizing serve
 Appropriately mimics the R2 signals:
 EXCEPTIONS: Net violation (display result and then player number)
 Outside antenna when the second referee's whistle ends the play
 Centerline faults (no number, result of play)
 Verbalizes or demonstrates end of set protocol. Whistle what you want the teams to do.
 Verbalizes or demonstrates end of match signal. Exits the stand and playing area immediately
 Addresses all match officials with respect and a positive attitude
 Aware of and protects support team (R2, scorer, assistant scorer, line judges) Quiz
 Aware of and addresses potential issues with coaches and players: Quiz on coach and bench control
 Aware of and addresses spectator issues and is able to verbalize proper procedure for crowd control (Quiz)
 Develops an awareness of back-row player situations
 Develops an awareness / system for recognition of player court positions and potential out of position

Set management

Starts play proper use of whistle and ends play (louder when selling a call) (louder and different for safety)
 Reaction time when recognizing faults and demonstrates comportment when whistling and signaling faults
 Centers on R2 (eye contact) at the end of every rally and accepts assistance as necessary
 Recognizes and whistles illegal contacts especially egregious contacts and appropriately stops rally
 Demonstrates the ability to call the set/match fairly, consistently
 Demonstrates professionalism (verbal and non-verbal reactions) and the ability to recover
 Verbalizes procedure to assess a sanction (Quiz) R1 will explain sanction to the floor captain (Quiz)
 Team delay sanction – card over correct wrist, accompanied by a whistle
 Individual sanction – card held on correct side accompanied by a whistle
 Procedure to acknowledge court captain and replacement of floor captain
